Neighbor to Neighbor is an exciting program that helps Union County residents stay in their own homes with help from volunteers. **It's neighbors helping neighbors.**

Members must reside in Union County, be at least 18 years old, complete an application and an in-person interview. Once membership is established, members may begin requesting services. For a small monthly fee, members are matched with volunteers to help with transportation and household tasks which can sometimes become a barrier to remaining independent. Neighbor to Neighbor also connects members to social and wellness programs and provides access to pre-screened service providers at a reduced cost.

Volunteers are background checked, go through a screening process and complete an in-person interview. This process both protects the members we serve and assures that each volunteer is offered assignments matching the volunteer's interests, skills and availability. Volunteers can choose which tasks to complete based on time and location. Projects and tasks could be anywhere in Union County and often take place in a member's home.

Support Membership

Support Membership is offered to those who want to demonstrate their support for Union County Neighbor to Neighbor, but do not intend to ask for services. Annual dues are discounted from regular Union County Neighbor to Neighbor membership. The entire dues amount may be listed as a charitable deduction on federal income tax forms. Support Members are encouraged to attend social programs and activities.
